Situated in the Mara and Simiyu regions in Tanzania, the Serengeti National Park marks the original migration route of wildebeest and zebras in this area. The diversity in landscapes of the park, which includes grassland plains, savannah, riverine forest and woodlands, allows abundance in the wildlife. For instance, both predators and preys thrive on these lands.
