Description

Designed and constructed from 1848 to 1884 in honor of George Washington, the first president of the United States, the Washington Monument stands high and proud at the center of Washington DC as the tallest building in the city. Once the tallest building in the world at 554 feet high, the Washington monument holds the title of the world's tallest stone structure and obelisk and represents the early foundation of the United States.
