Collis P. Huntington State Park,

1000 acres in the towns of Redding,
Newtown & Bethel. It houses vast
meadows, dense forests, multiple lakes as

horseback riding are popular here. The
park is named after the 19th-century
railroad baron, Collis Potter Huntington.
