Shakespeare's Birthplace is a half-timbered house located in Stratford-upon-Avon on the River Avon in England. The house was built around the mid-16th century and is, as its name suggests, the believed birthplace of William Shakespeare. After being restored in the 19th century, the house was transformed into a museum with interactive displays, exhibits, and information on the famous author's life.
