Description

Part of Matobo National Park, 3100 square kilometers of round granite kopjes form a wonderland called Matopos Hills. From this rock formation, the Mother and Child Kopjes are one of the most recognizable rocks in the park. On top of spectacular rock landforms, the park is home to rich faunal and floral diversity.
