Located in southwestern Uganda, the Bwindi Impenetrable National Park is named after the Bwindi Impenetrable Forest. Marking the border with the Democratic Republic of the Congo, the forest covers most of the park's area. Though rich in biodiversity, mountain gorillas are the most representative specie inhabiting the park.
