Ellis Island, just beside the New York Harbor, is where hundreds of thousands immigrants arrived and started their American story. Opened in 1990, the Museum is a noteworthy site retracing the history of the immigrants through displayed objects and expositions. It emphasizes the personal anecdotal stories and helps its visitors feel the type of emotions that played out on the island decades ago.
